SINGLE PETTY CONSIGNMENT

Increased exemption value of goods on which duty is not paid to US \$500 from US \$50 (inclusive of freight and insurance)



DRIVING LICENCES

Public Service Vehicles (PSV) driver's renewal period revised to annually instead of every 5 years



MOBILE COMMUNICATION Tax collection point for VAT on mobile phones to change from importation and point of sale to point of registration with ZICTA

RENTAL INCOME TAX

Rental Income Tax regime reform by charging Turnover Tax at 4 percent for income below K800,000 per annum. For rental income above K800,000, the income tax regime for individual or corporate will apply





CUSTOMS DUTY

custom duty on tyres for lorries, buses, construction and agriculture machinery reduced from 40 to 15 percent or K5 per kilogram
